#### Pair and Team competition:

In class LK1 only mixed pairs (f/m) and same-sex teams (f/f/f or m/m/m) are allowed to compete.

All Poomsae for each category will be drawn by lot out of the corresponding pool of compulsory Poomsae. The forms have to be presented in the same order they were drawn.

The drawing of all Poomsae will be undertaken by the competition commission on Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and will be announced immediately thereafter on <u>http://taekwondo.btdv.info/.</u>

Method of Competition – Recognized Poomsae:

#### **Single-Elimination System**

This method of competition is only applied to divisions under 30 & under 40 years (female and male).

#### Cut off system

1<sup>st</sup> Round (Preliminary, 20 or more contestants): Two Poomsae in accordance to drawing, the best 50% proceed to the next round. If there is an odd number of contestants, the number will be rounded to be made even (e.g. if there are 25 contestants, 13 will proceed).

2<sup>nd</sup> Round (semi-final, 9-19 contestants): Two Poomsae in accordance to drawing, the best 8 athletes will qualify for the final.

3<sup>rd</sup> Round (final, 1-8 contestants): Two Poomsae in accordance to drawing.

**Note**: individual, pair and team divisions up to 11 years – **Children** – will start immediately from semifinal (9 or more contestants) or final (1-8 contestants), there will be no preliminary round (1<sup>st</sup> round) in those divisions!

The organizer reserves themselves the right to limit the number of Poomsae in the 1<sup>st</sup> (preliminary) and/or 2<sup>nd</sup> (semi-final) round to one (1) form.

Procedure in case of equal point score:

a) In case there is a tied score at the last place of the best 50% after the completion of the preliminary round, respectively on the 8th rank of the semi-final round, the higher points in presentation will be the determining factor for advancement to the next round. If this score is equal as well, all athletes in question will proceed.

b) In case there is a tied score after the completion of the final round on the rank 1, 2, or 3, the contestant who is awarded more points in presentation shall be declared the winner. If the score is still tied, the one who has higher total points (including highest and lowest points) shall be the winner. If it is still tied, a rematch between the contestants in question shall be conducted. The referee will decide on the Poomsae to be performed (in any case one of the compulsory Poomsae).



# Class LK 2 (8th – 3rd Kup): age divisions as in class LK1 (see chart on top) METHODE OF COMPETITION:

# 1<sup>st</sup> Round (Preliminary, 9 contestants or more)

Two Poomsae at the contestant's own choice (see chart), best 50% qualify for the next round. If there is an odd number of contestants, the number will be rounded to be made even (e.g. 11 contestants > 6 will proceed)

2<sup>nd</sup> Round (Final, 1-8 contestants): Two Forms at own choice according to the following chart

 $8^{th}$  and  $7^{th}$  Kup: Repetition of both forms of the  $1^{st}$  round is possible in the final  $6^{th}$  and  $5^{th}$  Kup: Repetition of one form of the  $1^{st}$  round is possible in the final  $4^{th}$  and  $3^{rd}$  Kup: No repetition of any form allowed

**Pair and Team Competition**: The category of which the forms will be drawn from will depend on the pair/team member with the lowest Kup. Pairs and teams in class LK2 can be composed of athletes of different age divisions, the classification of age will depend on the oldest pair/team member. In class LK2 pairs may also be composed of same sex athletes (f/f or m/m), mixed teams (female + male team members) are in class LK2 also possible.

The organizer reserves themselves the right to limit the number of Poomsae in the 1<sup>st</sup> (preliminary) and/or 2<sup>nd</sup> (semi-final) round to one (1) form.
